

WORKSHOP ON AGRIBUSINESS

A high-level consultative workshop was held in

Quetta to develop a comprehensive roadmap for promoting agribusiness in Balochistan, with financial support from the European Union (EU) and technical assistance from GIZ's Technical and Vocational Education and Training Sector Support Program. It is an essential initiative towards establishing a Centre of Excellence for agribusiness in the province, which will be based at the Lasbela University of Agriculture, Water and Marine Sciences, Uthal.







The workshop was attended by the Governor Balochistan Sheikh Jafar Khan Mandokhail, Vice Chancellor of Lasbela University of Agriculture Water and Marine Sciences Prof. Dr. Abdul Malik Tareen, Vice Chancellor of University of Gwadar Dr. Abdul Razaq Sabir, Prof. Dr. Khalid, Professor Dr. Dost Muhammad Baloch, Vice Chancellor of University of Loralai Prof. Dr. Ehsanullah Kakar, Pro Vice Chancellor of LUAWMS Dr. Illahi Bakhsh Marghzani, Director General of National Vocational Technical Training Commission NAVTTC Dr. Hussain Bakhsh Magsi, Director General of Balochistan Technical Education Vocational Training Authority B-TEVTA

The participants included Governor Balochistan Sheikh Jafar Khan Mandokhaill, Vice Chancellor of LUAWMS Prof. Dr. Abdul Malik Tareen, Pro Vice Chancellor Dr. Illahi Bakhsh Marghzani, Dean of Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Dr. Nasrullah Bangulzai, Professor of the Faculty of Agriculture Dr. Muhammad Rashid, Dr. Abdul Hameed Baloch of the DVM Faculty and others expressedtheir views to the participants of the event. The speakers discussed the promotion of agribusiness in Balochistan and the adoption of modern trends to increase production, meet the growing population's food and other resource needs, promote food security, and create employment opportunities. In other critical consultative sessions, experts from various fields also presented their valuable suggestions. Addressing the participants, the speakers and experts appreciated the European Union's commitment to investing in agribusiness in Balochistan, while praising the initiatives of the National Vocational Technical Training Commission in the province. They highlighted its essential role in economic development, job creation, and poverty reduction, particularly in the launch of this vital project. They emphasised that promoting agribusiness in Balochistan can transform the province's economy and ensure food security. Experts said that the establishment of a Centre of Excellence for Agribusiness at Lasbela University of Agriculture, Water, and Marine Sciences (LUAWMS) will accelerate efforts to bring about innovation-based reforms in the province's production sector. They said that such initiatives will pave the way for sustainable development, improved value chains and overall promotion, which are still untapped in Balochistan.

SEMINAR ON CULTURE AND TOURISM

A seminar on "Heritage and Tourism" was organised at Lasbela University of Agriculture, Water, and Marine Sciences under the auspices of the Department of Culture and Tourism, Government of Balochistan, in collaboration with the Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialisation

(ORIC).

The speakers highlighted the ancient monuments, Indus Valley, the the Mehrgarhcivilisation and tourism in detail. The seminar was attended by Vice Chancellor Professor Dr. Abdul Malik Tareen, Secretary of the Department of Culture and Tourism Deputy Mr. Sohail-ur-Rehman Baloch. Commissioner of District Lasbela Humaira Baloch, Pro Vice Chancellor Dr. Illahi Bakhsh Marghzani, Director of ORIC Dr. Javed Meraj, deans, directors, and students from various faculties in large numbers. Professor Dr. Abdul Hameed Baloch, Kaleemullah Lashari, and others shared their views on the relevant topic.







The speakers stated that Balochistan is a unique destination in terms of tourism, offering numerous beautiful and enchanting places for sightseei including Spat, Kund Malir, and Ziarat. In addition, the city of Roghan in Bella has a distinct identity. The speakers stated that Balochistan offers a diverse range of tourism opportunities, including marine tourism, religious tourism, adventure tourism, and railway tourism. They added that the role of stakeholders is crucial highlight them. Addressing the event, the speakers stated that Mehrgarhcivilisation was a Neolithic archaeological site located in the Kachi Plain of Balochistan, Pakistan. It is considered one of the oldest known sites in South Asia, exhibiting evidence of agriculture and herding that dates back to around 7000 BC. This was the early period of Mehrgarh, characterised by polished stone tools and bone tools. The people of Mehrgarhpractised a combination of hunting, stockbreeding, and plant cultivation. Regarding the Indus Valley, the speakers said that overall, the Indus Valley Civilisation was a sophisticated and advanced civilisation that played a significant role in human history. Addressing the seminar, Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Abdul Malik Tareen stated that the eventwas rich in information about ancient civilisations.





He further noted that the participants' knowledge of the topic has increased. He expressed gratitude to the Secretary of the Culture and Tourism Department, Mr. Sohail-ur-Rehman Baloch, for organising such a seminar, including a cultural festival and a musical night, at Lasbela University. The Secretary of the Culture and Tourism Department, Mr. Sohail-ur-Rehman Baloch, said that the purpose of organising such seminars and cultural festivals is to promote tourism and provide awareness about ancient civilisations. 

At the same time, it ensures the transparent monitoring of research grants, project funding, and donor contributions.

The Supply Chain Management (SCM) module streamlines procurement, inventory, and vendor management. Project Systems (PS) support the planning, budgeting, and monitoring of institutional development initiatives. The Enterprise Asset Management (EAM) module offers a centralised solution for infrastructure maintenance and asset optimisation. Human Capital Management (HCM) handles all HR-related functions, including recruitment, payroll, leave, performance appraisals, and personnel records. Additionally, real-time analytics and reporting tools provide instant access to dashboards and KPIs for data-driven administrative decision-making.
